# I. Eligibility:

- ➤ A pass in two-year Intermediate Examination conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the University or Intermediate Board with the following subjects namely:
  - i) Physical Sciences
  - ii) Biological Sciences
- A candidate for admission under general category to B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree course, must have passed in each of the subjects of English, Physics, Chemistry & Biology, and obtained 50% marks in aggregate of these subjects (47.5% for SC/ST/PH category i.e., 5% less than that prescribed for the general category) at intermediate or its equivalent examination.

# II. Criteria for selection:

- ➤ The selection of candidates for all the seats shall be made on the basis of ranks obtained by the candidates in the **Telangana EAPCET-2025 under the agriculture stream** [Including Special quota seats in B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, B.Sc. (Hons.) Community Science, B.Tech. (Food Technology) and B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture courses] conducted by the Telangana Council for Higher Education.
- ➤ In case of a tie in ranks obtained by two or more candidates in the Telangana EAPCET-2025, the marks secured in the optional subjects of the qualifying examination (Intermediate or its equivalent) shall be taken into consideration. In case of a further tie, the age of the candidate shall be taken into consideration and the older candidate shall be given preference.

# III. Age:

- ➤ The candidates for admission into B.V.Sc. & A.H. course shall be required to have completed 17 years of age as on 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year of admission.
- ➤ The candidates for admission into B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, B.Sc. (Hons.) Community Science, B.Tech. (Food Technology), B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture and B.F.Sc. courses shall be required to have completed 17 years of age with an upper age limit of 22 years for all the candidates, 25 years in respect of SC and ST candidates, and 27 years for Physically Challenged candidates as on 31st December of the year of admission.

# **IV.** Reservation of the seats:

The rule of reservation (OC:46%, BC-A:7%, BC-B;10%, BC-C:1%, BC-D:7%, BC-E:4%, SC-Group-I:1%, SC- Group-II:9%, SC- Group-III:5%, ST:10%) shall be followed as per the rules. Similarly, the 10% reservation allocated to EWS category is supernumerary to the total intake (*The rule of reservation shall be followed as per the guidelines issued by the Government of Telangana from time to time*).

# \* Reservation of seats under Farmer's/Agriculture Labourers'/Rural quota

The seats for the candidates coming from the families of Agriculturalists cum Rural area (Farmers' Quota), and Agriculture Labourers' (Agriculture Labourers' Quota), and Rural Area alone (Rural Quota) have been reserved in various UG courses being offered by PJTAU, PVNRTVU and SKLTGHU. The details on the reservation of the seats under Farmer's, Agriculture Labourers' and Rural quotas in UG courses are given below.

# Note:

- ➤ <u>ANNEXURE-I</u>: It is a proforma to be certified by the Head of the Institution(s) with his office seal that the candidate has studied for a minimum period of four years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas (Non-Municipal Area Certificate).
- ➤ <u>ANNEXURE-II:</u> It is a proforma indicating the patta numbers and extent of land owned by the candidate/parent(s), duly certified by the Tahsildar with his office seal (or) attested photocopies of Pattadar Pass Book as evidence of the extent of agricultural land.
- > ANNEXURE-III: It is a proforma indicating the Job card (EGS card) number of the candidate/parent(s) and certifying that the candidate/parent(s)/grandparent(s) do not own any Agricultural Land, duly certified by the Tahsildar with his office seal.
- ➤ ANNEXURE-I/ANNEXURE-III need to be filled in with the signatures of concerned officials viz., Head of respective Institution(s) and Tahsildar, respectively, along with the office seal. Otherwise, the claim of the candidates under respective categories will be summarily rejected.

# **Reservation of seats under Special Categories:**

The counselling for the **Physically Challenged** (PH@5%), **Children of Armed Personnel** (CAP@2%), **National Cadet Corps** (NCC@1%) and **Sports** (@0.5%) quota seats shall be conducted in the presence of the officers of the departments concerned. The certificates of the candidates of the above special categories shall be verified by the officers, and the seats shall be allotted as per the priorities indicated by them. The University has no interference in indicating priorities.

# a. Reservation under Physically Handicapped Quota:

In various UG courses offered by PJTAU, PVNRTVU and SKLTGHU, 5% of seats are reserved for Physically Handicapped/Challenged candidates. The candidates seeking reservation under above quota shall be required to be present himself/herself before a Selection Committee comprising of Residential Medical Officer, Specialists in the concerned fields of medicine and Deans of Faculty, who shall examine the suitability of the candidates to the various courses. As a part of the selection process, the candidates seeking admission into various UG courses of PJTAU, PVNRTVU and SKLTGHU shall be required to perform the activities such as identification of slides through microscopes, operation of push/wheel hoes and walking on the bunds, spraying with knapsack/power sprayer, weeding & digging, irrigating the fields, reading from the blackboard, writing, threading the needle, hearing tests etc,.

# **Note:**

With regards to B.V.Sc. & AH course, the candidates with the following disabilities shall not be admitted under the 5% seats reserved for the Physically Handicapped/Challenged quota as per VCI (Veterinary Council of India) norms:

- 1. Disability of the total body, including disability of the chest or spine, of more than 50%.
- 2. Disability of the lower limb of more than 50%.
- 3. Disability of the upper limb.
- 4. Visually Handicapped Candidates and those with hearing disability.
- 5. Candidates with progressive diseases like myopathies etc.,
- 6. Disabilities that otherwise would interfere with the performance of the duties of a veterinarian.

# b. Reservation under Sports Quota:

As per G.O.Ms No. 2 of the Govt. of Telangana dated 22-09-2020, 0.5% of seats have been reserved under the Sports quota. A total of 31 Sports Disciplines have been indicated in the said G.O. All the candidates who wish to seek admissions in various Undergraduate courses of PJTAU, PVNRTVU & SKLTGHU are required to upload a copy of his/her sports achievements/ testimonials along with the Form I, II, III & IV (whichever is applicable) duly certified/attested by the concerned State Sports Associations recognized by the SATS which are categorized according to level of the championships. *Uploading of Form I, II, III & IV (whichever is applicable) is mandatory, otherwise, the candidates shall not be considered under the Sports Quota*. The above forms are also made available in the Online Admission application form.

The scrutiny of sports applications along with Form I, II, III & IV (as applicable) shall be done by the competent authority and subsequently by an evaluation committee for finalizing the priorities for allotment of the seats.

#### **Reservation of seats for Women:**

➤ In each course,  $33\frac{1}{3}\%$  of the seats shall be horizontally reserved in favour of women candidates from each category.

# V. Allocation of seats:

➤ Of the total seats, 85% of the seats are reserved for local candidates, and 15% of seats are unreserved.

# In this regard, as per the G.O. Ms. No. 15 of the Higher Education (TE) Department, Dated: 27-02-2025, the reservation of seats is as follows:

Admission to 85% of the seats shall be reserved in each course in the Educational Institutions in the State for local candidates of OU area as specified in the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulations and Admissions) Order, 1974 as subsequently amended and the remaining 15% of the seats shall be un-reserved seats to the following:

- a. All the candidates are eligible to be declared as local candidates of the O.U. area.
- b. Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of ten years, excluding periods of study outside the State, or either of whose parents has resided in the State for a total period of ten years, excluding periods of employment outside the State;
- c. Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities, and other similar quasi-public institutions within the State; and
- d. Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and educational institutions recognized by the Government or a University or other competent authority, and similar other quasi-Government institutions within the State.

<u>Note:</u> The guidelines issued by the Government of Telangana from time to time shall be followed scrupulously, including the reservations for 15% of seats under the Unreserved quota.

# VI. Hostel facility:

➤ Hostel facility shall be provided subject to the availability of accommodation in the respective colleges.

# VII. Original certificates to be produced at the time of counselling:

- SSC Memorandum of Marks or Equivalent Examination Certificate, showing the evidence of the Date of Birth.
- Pass Certificate cum Memorandum of Marks obtained by the applicant in the qualifying examination (Intermediate (10+2) or its Equivalent Examination).
- Telangana EAPCET-2025 Rank Card of Agriculture Stream.

- Bonafide/Study Certificate(s) from 1<sup>st</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> Class.
- Transfer Certificate of the institute last studied.
- Residence Certificate of Telangana.
- The certified copy of the Social Status Certificate issued by the competent authority of Telangana in case of applicants belonging to Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes, and Scheduled Tribes.
- The latest certified copy of the **EWS** Certificate valid for the year 2025-26 issued by the competent authority in case of applicants belonging to the EWS category.
- Non-Municipal Area Study Certificate (ANNEXURE-I), if applicable.
- Agricultural Land Holding Certificate (ANNEXURE-II), if applicable.
- Legal heir certificate, if applicable.
- Certificate claiming Agriculture Labourers' Quota (ANNEXURE-III), if applicable.
- The certified copy of the Physically Challenged Certificate, if applicable.
- Children of Armed Personnel Certificate / Defense Personnel Certificate, if applicable.
- National Cadet Corps (NCC) Certificate, if applicable.
- Sports and Games Certificates along with Form I, II, III & IV (whichever is applicable), which are mandatory for claiming a seat under the Sports quota, if applicable.

# **Note:**

- The candidate who secures a seat (Regular/Special quota) shall submit the certificates in Original along with the prescribed fees (in cash) at the time of counselling itself.
- The seats pertaining to Special Quota shall be filled based on ranks obtained by the candidates in the Telangana EAPCET-2025 of Agriculture Stream and the rule of reservation.
- The rules and regulations with regard to eligibility, age, reservations, etc., are the same for the Special quota that apply to the candidates admitted under the regular quota.
- The candidates selected under the Special quota shall be treated on par with regular quota students. No special amenities or facilities shall be provided.
- The Special quota seats in B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, B.Sc. (Hons.) Community Science, B.Tech. (Food Technology) and B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture shall be filled by separate counselling after filling up of regular quota seats.
- The unfilled seats under the special quota shall not be filled from any other stream and shall be kept vacant.
- The candidates admitted under the special quota are not eligible for any reimbursement of fees or educational concessions offered by the Government.

# IX. Other information:

- > The guidelines issued by the Government of Telangana from time to time shall be followed scrupulously, including the reservations.
- ➤ The University may send SMS to the applicants for the purposes related to counselling. Hence, the candidates are informed to mention their personal mobile numbers but not the mobile numbers of relatives, friends, net/online/xerox centers, etc.
- ➤ 20% of seats in B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, B.Sc. (Hons.) Community Science, B.Tech. (Food Technology) and B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture under ICAR quota shall be filled up by ICAR through the online counselling based on ranks obtained in CUET (UG) ICAR 2025 examination conducted at the national level.
- ➤ In the event of the establishment of new colleges, such seats shall also be considered for filling up through this notification only.
- ➤ The Counselling/Verification under special categories (PH, CAP, NCC & SPORTS) shall be held in the presence of the authorities concerned, and seats shall be allotted as per the priorities indicated by the officers concerned.
- ➤ If the admitted candidate cancels/withdraws his/her seat <u>before the closure of admission process</u>, the entire fee collected from the student shall be refunded in full after deducting Rs. 2,000/- (@ Rs. 10,000/- for Special quota) as processing fee.

- Any cancellation/withdrawal of admissions <u>after the closure of the admission process</u>, the candidate shall forfeit the entire fees (except the caution deposits). In addition, the candidate has to pay Rs. 2,000/- (@ Rs. 10,000/- for Special quota) as processing fee.
- > The candidate who secures a seat should submit the certificates in Original along with the prescribed fees (in cash) at the time of counselling itself.
- ➤ During the counselling process, the seat availability position shall be updated at the end of the day and hosted on the University's website <a href="www.pjtau.edu.in">www.pjtau.edu.in</a>. The candidates are requested to go through the above information hosted on the website and accordingly attend the counselling. No separate communication shall be sent in this regard.
- ➤ The University does not guarantee any employment to the candidates.
- ➤ The applicant is informed that mere submission of an online application and attending counselling do not guarantee the allotment of a seat.
- > Candidates are required to read the PROSPECTUS thoroughly before applying.
- ➤ Professor Jayashankar Telangana Agricultural University (PJTAU) is the only Agricultural University in the State. The University has not accorded any affiliation to any private colleges in Telangana.
- ➤ P.V. Narsimha Rao Telangana Veterinary University (PVNRTVU) is the only University in the State offering B.V.Sc. & A.H. and B.F.Sc. Degree courses and there are no affiliated private colleges under this University.
- > Registrars of the respective Universities are responsible for the information furnished in the prospectus related to their courses.
- ➤ The University is not responsible for the information provided on other websites.
- ➤ Parents and Students are informed that the admissions are purely based on merit and guidelines of the University, and as such, they are requested not to rely on any middlemen/persons/consultants who try to mislead the students in securing admission into PJTAU, PVNRTVU and SKLTGHU under any quota.
- ➤ All the regular and special quota seats shall be filled through the combined counselling only.
- ➤ In case the information furnished or the certificates uploaded by the candidates are found to be false, the University shall take appropriate action against the individuals concerned, and his/her application shall be summarily rejected.
